Dumping duty on Chinese radial tyres

New Delhi, September 21 The Finance Ministry has imposed definitive anti-dumping duty on certain new Chinese radial tyres (including tubeless) used in buses and lorries/trucks. The antidumping duty, unless revoked earlier, will be valid for a period of five years. The Automotive Tyre Manu-

The Automotive Tyre Manufacturers Association had filed the petition on behalf of Apollo Tyres Ltd, JKTyre Industries Ltd and Ceat Ltd. Based on the recommendations of the Designated Authority in the Commerce Ministry, the revenue department has now imposed definitive antidumping duty that ranged from \$245.35 per tonne to \$452.33 per tonne.
